Why do we need a PPG?

There have been a lot of changes at Appletree Medical Practice in recent times; the arrival of new GP Partners; becoming a Training Practice; the arrival of new clinicians—e.g. Clinical Pharmacists, Advanced Clinical Practitioners; adopting new clinical and telephone systems; building the new pharmacy unit and surgery extensions to name just a few.

Nationally the NHS in general, and Primary Care in particular is undergoing transformational change as outlined in the NHS Paper "General Practice Forward View" (April 2016).

Appletree Medical Practice is not isolated from all this environmental turbulence. What does Appletree PPG do?

To be valuable the PPG must have the confidence to challenge the Practice in line with any issue brought forward. It is self organising and patient led.

The benefits of an effective PPG are felt by the patients, the Practice and the wider community in which it operates.
